## **VA DECA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

The Virginia DECA Foundation makes the Virginia DECA Scholarship Program possible through donations and dues. DECA is an organization of students enrolled in marketing programs and is designed to prepare emerging leaders and entrepreneurs in Marketing, Management, Hospitality, and Finance.

# **PURPOSE OF THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

The DECA Scholarship Program is designed to assist DECA members who wish to further their education in pursuit of their career goals. All VA DECA members are encouraged to apply.

# **APPLYING**

Step 1: Apply online: coming soon!

Step 2: Electronically attach the required documentation to the application.

Application AND Required Documentation MUST BE RECEIVED by VA DECA DECEMBER 12, 2025

# WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Any high school senior who:

- is an active DECA member,
- is currently enrolled or will be enrolled in a marketing course for the current school year,
- has a minimum GPA of 2.5,
- has a minimum Marketing GPA of 3.0,
- and intends to pursue a postsecondary education/technical training program.

Each chapter is limited to no more than **five (5) applicants per school year**. Chapter advisor(s) should determine which applications are submitted to the Virginia DECA Scholarship Committee, ensuring that each chapter does not exceed its allocation of applicants.

# WHAT IS THE SELECTION PROCESS?

- Applications are reviewed and ranked in order of merit with other applicants based on the included rubric.
- The scholarship committee will select finalists based on the score earned on each submitted application packet.
- The top students will be invited to a virtual panel interview.
- The pre-screening score will be added to the interview score to determine the recipients of the scholarships.
- Students are applying for a pool of scholarships, not a specifically named scholarship. No renewal of scholarships will be awarded.
- Scholarship finalists must attend SLC competitors or SLDA participants.
- INTERVIEWS WILL BE SCHEDULED ON MONDAY, FEBRUARY 23, AND TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 24, 2026.
- Scholarship recognition will be presented at SLC.
- Funds will be disbursed directly to the postsecondary education/technical training program after proof of program enrollment and a copy of a thank you letter to the donor has been received by the Marketing and Related Cluster Specialist.

# SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION VIRGINIA DECA DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS

#### WHAT MUST BE INCLUDED:

NOTE: ALL required documentation must be submitted with the online application (cover letter, reference letters, transcript, signature page).

#### **APPLICATION**

Please complete and apply online. The application will not be submitted if a required field has not been completed.

### **COVER LETTER/LETTER OF INTRODUCTION**

Please include a cover letter to introduce yourself, explain your specific career objective, and actions taken or planned to accomplish this goal (include education and/or employment). Please limit to one (1) page in length. This is a letter; it should be addressed to the scholarship committee and signed by the applicant.

# **REFERENCE LETTERS**

Include two (2) reference letters. ALL letters must be signed.

- DECA Reference: Letter from DECA Chapter Advisor.
- **Business/School/Other Professional Reference:** Personal reference letter from an employer, school counselor or official, coach, or other professional individual able to speak to the applicant's ability to conduct themselves in a professional manner, work with others, and drive to succeed.

## **TRANSCRIPTS**

Include a current transcript with an explanation of terms and scale. The transcript must include final grades from the end of the student's Junior/11th Grade year. The transcript must include the current year's enrollment and the applicant must be enrolled in a marketing class during the current year.
